Budget Amendment Resolution

Mrs. Bricker made a motion to approve the following budget amendment. Mr. Foreman seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

WHEREAS Campbell County School District Number One is a nonprofit political subdivision of the State of Wyoming formed to provide public education in grades K-12 for persons residing within its boundaries;

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to increase the Grant Special Revenue Fund 20 in the amount of \$15,000,000 to account for grants awarded during the fiscal year including ESSER I, ESSER II, and the possible award of ARP funding;

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to increase the Depreciation Fund 31 in the amount of \$4,000,000 and adjust the General Fund 01 for a potential operating transfer from the General Fund 01 to the Depreciation Fund 31 for projects including Equipment Replacement, Aquatic Center Replacement, and Security Projects;

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to increase the Nutrition Services Fund 50 in the amount of \$900,000 for increased revenues and expenses due to operating under the Summer Food Program during the majority of 2020-2021;

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to adjust all General Funds to account for budget journal entries and minor operating transfers throughout the fiscal year, as well as adjusting contingency accounts to meet the needs of the District.

BÉ IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees, Campbell County School District Number One, Gillette, Wyoming, this 8th day of June, 2021, hereby approves the budget amendment as stated above.

"Ghost Employees"

Dr. Ayers provided information regarding the term "ghost employees". He defined "ghost employees" as positions generated by the funding model but not hired by the District. The funding model determines the amount of money available to the District; however, it doesn't dictate how the funds are spent. Representative Eric Barlow also provided information regarding the legislative model and the evidence based model. The interim Joint Education Committee will meet in July.

Junior High Head Coaches

Dr. Ayers discussed the possibility of identifying head coaches at the junior high level to replace former facilitator positions. Mr. Foreman made a motion to allow junior high activity directors to determine a head coach or lead person to replace former facilitator positions for basketball, football, soccer, track, and volleyball. The head coach or lead person will receive a stipend of 95% of 2% of the base. Mr. Steiger seconded the motion. Discussion was had, and the motion carried unanimously.

School Year 2021-2022 Capital Projects Lists Mr. Holmes shared a list of capital projects for the 2021-2022 school year. Dr. Lawrence made a motion to approve the presented list of capital projects for the 2021-2022 school year. Mr. Foreman seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Dr. Lawrence made a motion to approve the EMS recommendation to move the position of Network Engineer to Pay Range Non-Exempt-14; and for Behavior Assistant and Westwood Secretary to remain at their current Pay Range. Mr. Foreman seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

Policy 4180, Staff Development; and Administrative Regulation 4180-R Staff Development; and Policy 4036, Dr. Reznicek provided information regarding Policy 4180, Staff Development; Administrative Regulation 4180-R, Staff Development; and proposed Policy 4036, Educational Support Personnel (ESP) Certification Incentive Program. Two public hearings were held regarding Policy 4036, Educational Support Personnel (ESP) Certification Incentive Program. Ernie Saunders attended the public hearings and asked

Educational Support Personnel (ESP) Certification Incentive Program the Board to consider allowing employees who currently receive a stipend, continue to receive the stipend for one year while they work on the new stipend requirements. He also believed "lead" employees and others who supervise should carry the same level of certification as those they supervise.

Dr. Lawrence made a motion to approve revisions to Policy 4180, Staff Development; adopt Policy 4036, Educational Support Personnel (ESP) Certification Incentive Program with the condition that employees currently receiving a stipend be allowed to continue to receive the stipend for one year while they work on the new stipend requirements; and to rescind Administrative Regulation 4180-R, Staff Development. Mr. Foreman seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Foreman made a motion to adopt Policy 4014, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and the Americans with Disabilities Act; and Policy 4012 and Administrative Regulation 4012-R, Non-Discrimination and Anti-Harassment; and to rescind Policy 4011, American with Disabilities Act and Policy 4010 Equal Opportunity, Title VI, Title IX, Immigration Act and Section 504 and Administrative Regulation 4010-R, Equal Opportunity, Title VI, Title IX, Immigration Act and Section 504. Mrs. Durgin seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

The Board celebrated the completion of work on policies until next school year.
