Safety Sensitive Routes

Bus Routes 36, 63, 83, 84, 89, 91, 92, 110, 124, and 125 were approved for safety-sensitive issues due to a physical barrier that would prevent a student from safely walking to school or a safety hazard that could cause the student harm. Enrollment Update

Mr. Eisenhaur provided an enrollment update. The total number of students enrolled is 8,810, which is a decrease of 54 since the first day of school and is typical after the statutorily required ten-day drop for those who have moved.

Calendar Committee Update

Mr. Eisenhauer provided a calendar committee update and reviewed the 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 proposed Version A and B draft calendars with the board and asked for feedback. Mr. Eisenhauer shared that the next step is to take the calendar drafts to the principal's leadership meeting, share them with staff, and ask for input. The final drafts for each version will go to the board for approval at the October 25 board meeting.
