Technology Update

Director of Technology Brian Knox provided an educational technology update on the District's infrastructure, inventory, management of devices with filters, the plan for device replacement for FY25, installation of panels, the Schoology program, and AI (artificial intelligence), which is changing the world of education.

Parental Rights Policy and Administrative Regulation

Dr. Reznicek provided information and requested approval on the proposed first reading of Policy 5153 Parental Rights and Administrative Regulation 5153-R Parental Rights, which are required due to Senate File No. SF0009 passing in the legislature.

Safety Updates

Mr. Bartlett, SRO Greg Baker, and SRO Kris Hunter provided a safety update and information on the secondary and elementary schools. They discussed monitoring entry doors, checking in all visitors with Raptor, BluePoint pull stations, safety committee meetings, monthly tabletop drills, training, reviewing protocols with the Sheriff's Office and Police Department, and information sent from Homeland Security. Mr. Bartlett shared that safety and security are taken very seriously, and learning is always ongoing to improve protocols.
