School Year 2024-2025 Capital Projects List

Mr. Bartlett reviewed proposed capital projects for the school year 2024-2025 in the estimated amount of \$6,935,959.00.

Dr. Lawrence made a motion to approve the 2024-2025 capital projects as listed. Mrs. Goehring seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.

MCER Update

Mr. Bartlett provided information to the Board about a MCER (Most Cost-Effective Remedy) Study. The State is required to conduct a most cost-effective remedy study when any building has a projected capacity exceeding 100%, an FCI (Facility Condition Index) score exceeding 0.3, or is inadequate to deliver the required educational services under the state rules Chapter 3, Section 8. The remedy must be able to deliver the educational programming and meet adequacy standards.

Mr. Bartlett provided an update on the following Campbell County School District facilities: Transportation Department MCER Study was based on Chapter 3, Section 8, and was self-performed by the Department. The Commission approved the facility's replacement recommendation and design funding is available. Replacement construction/demolition funds will be recommended in the upcoming supplemental budget. The ongoing MCER Study for Conestoga was based on a facility conditions index score of .378. The current MCER Study for Campbell County High School was based on Chapter 3, Section 8. The Study will determine a replacement or renovation remedy.

**Public Comments** 

Public comments included concerns about a textbook's content on the agenda and concerns with the Camporee using the facilities and taking potential use away from the local taxpayers.

Trustee Celebrations

Chairman Ochs shared that the Educational Service Center has been without air conditioning for a couple of weeks. The work is complete, and it is back on. The building is cool and comfortable thanks to the District's fantastic maintenance department and all who worked on the system to get it working.
