Staff Communicators
Assembly

Dr. Brown introduced the Staff Communicators Assembly who presented their salary and benefit recommendations for 2018-2019. Certified employee representatives Travis Heitmann and Ruth Wenz presented the following recommendations:

- Freeze stipend of 3% of current salaries,
- Loyalty stipend in the amount of \$300.00 for staff who have been frozen in salary for one year,
- Loyalty stipend in the amount of \$600.00 for staff who have been frozen in salary for two years, and
- Add an additional \$500 to the base to increase from \$47,500.00 to \$48,000.00, and
- Horizontal Lane Change Requests be granted

Educational Support Personnel representative Ernie Saunders, Jenny Mashak and Melody Quenzer presented the following recommendations:

- Freeze stipend of 3% of current salaries,
- Loyalty stipend in the amount of \$300.00 for staff who have been frozen in salary for one year,
- Loyalty stipend in the amount of \$600.00 for staff who have been frozen in salary for two years; and

Campbell County High School
Facility Evaluation

Mr. Eisenhower shared information on the Campbell County High School Facility Evaluation. Campbell County School District commissioned Associated Construction Engineering to provide a comprehensive condition assessment of the main high school building and the Vocational "G" Building. Total probable costs for replacement/upgrade of the systems is approximately \$81,000,000.00.

Chairman Ochs made a formal request for administration to find the most cost-effective remedy regarding Campbell County High School. A motion was made by Mr. Foreman, and Mr. Lawrence seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
