School Improvement Goals:

Our school improvement goals will focus on 3 areas identified in our Rawhide School improvement strategic plan for the 2021 - 2022 academic school year. Our school has excelled in providing strong Tier II intervention to our students that positively impacts our Growth and Equity categories on the State Accountability Report in the past. Unfortunately, this school year, the report does not include either of these two categories - Growth & Equity. This academic school year we will focus on Tier I instructional practices targeting our Achievement category in WYTOPP. Here are our school areas of focus for the 2021 - 2022 academic school year.

Goal 1 - 51% of Rawhide students will meet and/or exceed expectations as measured by (WYTOPP) in Language Arts.

Goal 2 - 51% of Rawhide students will meet and/or exceed expectations as measured by (WYTOPP) in Mathematics.

<u>Goal 3</u> - By spring of 2022, 70% of all Rawhide ELL students will show growth toward program exit by metric point (0.5) as measured by the WIDA assessment.

Rawhide (Strive for Success) Strategies driven by student Data;

- Weekly data dive focused on developing common practices across grade levels.
- Vertical alignment conversation between grade levels to provide areas of focus within grade level.
- Provide coaching and professional development to improve Tier 1 instruction, in turn, minimizing the number of students in need of intervention.
- Flexibility in schedule (for the first time ever we have all staff at RH and not sharing with other schools) to provide targeted, timely Tier II interventions.
