Dr. Ayers listed the topics for the meeting: 1) Enrollment Update

<u>Enrollment Update</u> - Mr. Eisenhauer shared an enrollment update with the board. The enrollment number at the end of the first day of school was 8864 students, which is a slight increase from the prior year. Mr. Eisenhauer pointed out that Sage Valley Junior High and Twin Spruce Junior High are unique, with 680 students each. Mr. Eisenhauer reviewed an enrollment history graph which showed enrollment trends for the past several years.

<u>Other</u> – Further discussion was had regarding classroom sizes throughout the district, and trustees asked that the administration update them after Labor Day on student numbers and class sizes.

Mr. Eisenhauer reviewed the assignments for the newly combined principal positions in the district. These include Rawhide Elementary/Recluse Elementary Principal Dane Weaver and Meadowlark Elementary/Little Powder Elementary Principal Lindy Watt. Principal Derek Barnhurst will continue with Cottonwood Elementary/4-J Elementary.
