Dr. Ayers listed the topics for the meeting: 1) Policy Committee Update; 2) STEM Curriculum

Policy Committee Update – Dr. Larry Reznecik updated the board regarding policy work and shared that policies are reviewed every five years. The committee is in the process of reviewing human resource policies.

Elementary STEM and Computer Science Curriculum –Brandon Crosby, Curriculum Director, and Sam Burr, STEM Facilitator, gave an overview of the district elementary STEM and computer science curriculum. Expectations include the following: all students JK-6 engage in the STEM lab for a minimum of 45-minutes weekly; classroom teachers are not only present but actively engaged during STEM lab time, and STEM facilitators are to follow the STEM Playbook pacing and learning objectives associated with each learning engagement to ensure equity and curricular rigor among all CCSD #1 students; STEM facilitators and classroom teachers are given collaboration time at minimum once a semester to plan meaningful and innovative integration of classroom content learning; STEM teachers report proficiency levels of all students on required DAS assessment components in PowerSchool; STEM teachers will continue to develop cross-curricular learning engagements for each grade level, the goal being that every grade level has one required cross-curricular unit to create greater equity for all students.
