1. Information Items – Dr. Ayers shared the following items:

- Dr. Ayers thanked the board for the members who attended and gave speeches at the high school graduations.

- 2. Appeals Process Human Resources Manager Larry Reznicek provided information and the history of the District's ESP wage appeals process conducted every June. There are four goals in mind for the process: improve ESP wages, create a schedule that shows growth, create job descriptions that have essential functions, and give a raise on current wages. The District uses the consultant EMS (Educational Management Solutions) as the reviewer. Several mini-wage studies have been conducted since 2005. There is a three-phase approach to studying compensation, which includes internal equity analysis, market analysis, and findings and implementation. Dr. Reznicek shared that the appeals process this year affects 639 staff.
