 - Revising the Individualized Education Program: <u>The I.E.P. will be revised on the anniversary date or upon</u> request by appropriate person(s).
 - Conducting the multidisciplinary assessment: <u>Campbell County School District #1 or N.E.W. BOCES will schedule and contract for updating any necessary assessments that may be needed.</u>
 - Notifying and involving the student's parents of these activities Campbell County School District #1 and/or N.E.W. BOCES will provide appropriate notification.
- That this agreement does not provide services to any student placed in a residential treatment facility or group home under W.S. 21-13-315 subsequent to a court order.
- That this agreement does not provide for any medical services or any other services that are not authorized in the Wyoming Rules and Regulations Governing Services to Children with Disabilities.
- That any psychological counseling rendered by a mental health specialist to the parents or guardians of the student service by this agreement shall be limited to interpreting the student's educational needs, and providing information concerning the student's development, consistent with the terms stated by the District in Item 3 of this agreement.
- That if at any time during the performance of this agreement, the District determines that the services are not
 progressing satisfactorily or within the terms of this agreement, the District, at its discretion and after giving
 reasonable written notice to the Contractor, may terminate this agreement or any parts thereof within 30 days.
 At such termination date, the Contractor shall be entitled to payment for all services rendered and accepted by
 the District.
- That in providing these services the Contractor shall work through the following staff member of the District

 during the billing period.
- That all District expenditures related to the agreement shall be subject to audit by WDE.
- That in rendering these services the District and the Contractor shall comply with the Wyoming Rules and Regulations Governing Services to Children with Disabilities, the Wyoming State Board of Education Rules and Regulations Governing Entitlements under Section 21-13-309e of the Wyoming Education Code; the policies and procedures of the District; and shall have all the rights and protections of W.S. 21-2-501 and 21-2-502.
- That the staff of the Contractor shall be in compliance with the certification standards established by the Wyoming Professional Teaching Standards Board and the WDE School Improvement Unit. Any other person(s) who render services under this agreement shall be appropriately licensed, certified or registered.
- That the Contractor shall be subject to and comply with Title VI, Title IX, Section 504, ADA, IDEA, and any subsequent amendments to these acts; and all regulations promulgated thereunder.
- That the District shall state below pertinent accreditation's, licenses, and certifications which indicate the Contractor or subcontractor is qualified to provide these services:
