#### **SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT GOALS**

ELA: Prairie Wind will promote continued improvement in ELA by implementing UFLI, Panorama curriculum, and using the district's phonics, vocabulary, and reading pacing for each grade level. Prairie Wind will continue to target learning cycles, use of data, and explicit instruction in teaching core curriculum to support student achievement and growth.

MATH: Prairie Wind will continue to use the math curriculum, Eureka, to promote growth in Math. Teachers will use AVMR screeners to discover specific needs for interventions and AVMR strategies to fill the learning gaps for those students who need it.

SCIENCE: By implementing the Panorama curriculum along with hands-on science activities, Prairie Wind aims to meet or exceed the State average in Science scores. Regular assessments and feedback will help track the progress and make adjustments to ensure the success of this goal.

WELL-BEING: Prairie Wind teachers will continue to implement class meetings, trauma based practices, and use necessary programs to aid in wellness in the classroom. Prairie Wind will use PBIS practices driven by school data.

### **ACCOUNTABILITY REPORT GOALS**

EQUITY: Prairie Wind will be cognizant of the achievement gap of the identified equity students and address the gaps using interventions, ELO, and study skills that are necessary to improve a students success. Frequent communication and monitoring about testing and interventions used with these students will be necessary to aid in this success.

ACHIEVEMENT/GROWTH: Prairie Wind will maintain or exceed a score of meeting expectations on the growth and achievement targets as measured by the 23-24 WAEA School Performance Report.
