Application of both Imagine Learning and iXL programs will be implemented as supplements to daily instruction.

→ Strategic Goal: Student reflections will continue to be utilized after data obtained from CFA's, DSPA's, and Wy-Topp interim completed with interventions as necessary.

### Well-being:

→ Strategic Goal: Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) lessons will be presented each Wednesday of the week during 5th period.
