SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT GOALS

ELA:

Recluse Elementary will improve 3rd grade ELA proficiency on the 2023-2024 WY-TOPP Assessment from 0% to 50% proficient or advanced by focusing on priority standards, the use of proficiency scales to meet student needs, and Guided Reading groups with more targeted interventions.

MATH:

Recluse Elementary will improve 6th grade Math proficiency on the 2023-2024 WY-TOPP Assessment from 0% in our 5th grade cohort to 100% proficient or advanced in our 2023-2024 6th grade cohort by focusing on priority standards, continued teacher growth in the implementation of Eureka Math in addition to applying AVMR strategies in Guided Math groups.

SCIENCE:

Recluse teachers will embed more scientific texts into the language arts curriculum on a regular basis as well as a focus on reading and creating graphs and diagrams.

WELL-BEING:

Recluse will implement Character Strong, including monthly characteristics discussed daily.

ACCOUNTABILITY REPORT GOALS

ACHIEVEMENT:

Recluse Elementary will improve from 65% Meets Target to 68% Exceeding Targets on the Achievement Target as measured by the 2023-2024 WAEA School Performance Report.

GROWTH:

Recluse Elementary will improve from a 66 MGP (mean student growth percentile) Exceeding Target to a 68 MPG Exceeding Target on the Growth Indicator as measured by 2023-2024 WY TOPP Assessment.

EQUITY:

All consolidated subgroup students in Math and/or Reading will be identified and provided appropriate interventions as needed.
