6300 Request to Conduct Research

Any person who wishes to conduct research of any type, or who desires to have Campbell County School District students participate in any graduate or internship program, must receive prior approval from District administration. All requests to conduct research, or to have students or staff participate in any graduate or internship program, must be submitted in writing submit 6300-Form, Request to Conduct Research, and all additional required information.

Requests must include an outline of what is to be done, who is to be involved, and how the results will be used and distributed. A committee consisting of the <u>deputy</u> <u>superintendent</u>, <u>associate superintendent for instruction</u>, <u>the director of curriculum</u>, <u>assessment</u>, <u>and staff development</u>, one elementary administrative representative, <u>and</u> one secondary administrative representative, <u>and the assistant superintendent for curriculum and assessment</u> will review each request and make a recommendation to the <u>Ss</u>uperintendent for <u>his/her</u> approval.
