Dr. Ayers listed the topics that will be presented at the meeting: 1) Board Committee Reports; 2) DLI Update.

Board Committee Reports – Larry Reznecik updated the board regarding policy work. Policies and Administrative Regulations 5027 Homeless Children, Policy 5110 Surrogate Parent, Policy 5130 Activities Participant Drug Testing, and Policy 6144 Library Media Services are currently being reviewed.

Dennis Holmes shared that the ARP committee met with two stakeholder groups for input. The committee is currently gathering information for the narratives, and there is a listening session scheduled for January 5, 2022. The final application will be submitted on January 18, 2022.

Dual Language Immersion – Rawhide Elementary Principal Bertine Bahige and Stocktrail Elementary Principal Keri Shannon shared that the first kindergarten class of DLI “Pioneer students” from Stocktrail Elementary will be in 7th grade next fall, and they have been working on the transition plan in conjunction with Twin Spruce Junior High. Thirty-five students will be transitioning in the fall of 2022, and Twin Spruce Junior High Principal Dana Lyman shared they are very excited for the program to begin.
