PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Cal Ripken, Sr. Foundation (CRSF) in partnership with Devon Energy will provide resources and funding for a district-wide initiative aimed at bolstering students' knowledge and engagement in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) fields. Focusing on the Engineering design Process and KidSpark STEM Pathways, the initiative seeks to equip students with essential skills and knowledge for future careers in engineering and other STEM-related fields. Additionally, the initiative will offer comprehensive support and resources for teachers to effectively integrate CRSF STEM products such as BOLTS, Ozobots, and Snap Circuits into their classrooms.
