4675 Copyright

It is the expectation of the board of school trustees that all school employees will adhere to all the provisions of the copyright laws. Copyright protection extends to literary works; musical works; dramatic works; pantomimes; and choreographic works; pictorial, graphic and sculptural works; and other visual works, including audio and visual recordings and computer software.

Any use or reproduction of copyright materials will be done either with the written permission of the copyright holder or within the bounds of "Fair Use" guidelines provided in the Copyright Act; otherwise, the individual responsible for use or reproduction may be liable for infringing the copyright under existing laws.

Campbell County School District employees may use or reproduce copyrighted materials under the provisions of the copyright laws currently in force under Title 17 of the United States Code. Where questions arise, they should be submitted to the building administrator, who will provide answers or contact appropriate personnel to receive answers to questions posed.
