Campbell County School District has adopted the Wyoming Content and Performance standards as the district's standards. This includes standards for the following areas:

- Science
- Social Studies
- Health
- Physical Education
- Fine and Performing Arts
- Career/Vocational
- Foreign Language
- Computer Science (2022)

The curriculum and assessment system must be designed and implemented through a collaborative process that originates with the state standards and assessment blueprints to develop a framework for proficiency in learning the knowledge and skills necessary to achieve the state graduation standards. In doing so, the inferences pertaining to equity of educational outcomes empower all students to apply their educational skills successfully to future opportunities.
