

6260 Fire and Safety Drills

Conducting routine fire and safety drills are a critical component to school safety. Drills teach students and staff about their response during an emergency. Fire and safety drills should be conducted every month and documented properly. A safety drill can be conducted in lieu of a fire drill, as long as a minimum of four fire drills are completed during each academic school year. However, regardless of a fire or safety drill, the fire alarm should be tested every month. Acceptable safety drills include tornado, shelter in place, lockdown, and evacuation. Monthly fire or safety drills are a requirement of the state, and should be conducted in accordance with state laws.
