## **Immunizations**

## Mandatory Immunizations for Children Attending Schools; Exceptions

(Wyoming State Statute: 21-4-309)

- 1. Students of Campbell County School District will abide by Wyoming State Statute: 21-4-309 (a)
  - a. Contact school nurses, public health official or health care provider for clarification or more information regarding Wyoming State Statute: 21-4-309.
- 2. Wyoming State Statute: 21-4-309 requires students of Campbell County School District to provide proof of adequate immunization status, proof of progression to obtain adequate immunization status, or appropriate documentation of a religious or medical exemption for required vaccinations within 30 calendar days of school entry. Students not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to attend school until the above stated requirement is met.
- 3. Students of Campbell County School District may obtain required vaccinations from personal health care providers or the Campbell County Public Health Department.
- 4. Campbell County Public Health Department provides free **required** immunizations to students 18 years and younger. Parents must accompany students under the age of 18 to immunization clinics to provide consent. Campbell County Public Health requests students bring all previous shot records to immunization clinics.
