Functions

Analyzes assigned music prior to rehearsal (e.g. correct tempos, challenging transitions, dynamics, etc.) for the purpose of ensuring efficient use of rehearsal time.

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- Assists the Choral Instructor for the purpose of training students in the art of accompaniment.
 - Assists the teacher in supervising student activities for the purpose of ensuring efficient use of class time.
 - Exhibits professional and stage etiquette for the purpose of maintaining the professionalism of musical productions.
- Performs other related duties, as assigned, for the purpose of ensuring the efficient and effective functioning of the work unit.
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- Rehearses with choral groups for the purpose of playing full and sectional accompaniment.

Job Requirements: Minimum Qualifications

Skills, Knowledge and Abilities

SKILLS are required to perform multiple, technical tasks with a potential need to upgrade skills in order to meet changing job conditions. Specific skills required to satisfactorily perform the functions of the job include: none specified.

KNOWLEDGE is required to perform basic math, including calculations using fractions, percents, and/or ratios; read technical information, compose a variety of documents, and/or facilitate group discussions; and solve practical problems.
