Campus Options

Dr. Strahorn introduced Principal Larry Steiger and asked him to report on the work done by the committee to look into options for the campus. Mr. Steiger reviewed a handout which summarized information from other districts of similar size, results of a survey of staff and students, effects of the changed attendance policy on recent classes, and a recommendation to continue to have an open lunch period at North Campus. Parent Joy Beatty spoke in favor of a closed lunch, Parent Craig Skinner spoke in favor of an open lunch, and Students Nicole Clikeman and Emily Schroeder spoke as representatives of the senior and junior classes respectively to continue an open campus. Following discussion, Dr. Fall noted that the Board would take the information under advisement and that if any changes to the current configuration is contemplated, public hearing would be held.

Facilities Update

Dr. Brown reported on the current status of projects:  
Hillcrest Elementary School is on schedule and going well.  
Prairie Wind Elementary School is a little behind with most of the foundation in and drainage work completed.  
Westwood High School is being discussed with information being gathered and options considered.  
Lakeview Elementary School is in the planning process with the School Facilities Commission as well as with the City of Gillette.  
The Recreation Center is on schedule with approximately one-third of the roof completed.  
The major maintenance list bids will begin to appear on the agenda.
