100 students from last year. The Campbell County Virtual School has about 150 students enrolled, junior high non-classroom virtual learning has about 45 students, and high school non-classroom virtual learning has about 75 students. Those numbers are

still changing.

Board Meeting Format Discussion was had regarding the format of upcoming board meetings. The board will

audience.

Legislative Update Mr. Holmes provided a legislative update. Preliminary work is being done on

recalibration. The Picus Odden report is expected later in the fall.

Facility Update Mr. Holmes provided a facility update. The WJSH gym refurbishment is completed. The

new Kid Clinic, which is a partnership with Campbell County Health, should break ground in about two weeks. The new Aquatic Center is planned to be located at the Energy Capital Sport Complex. The Aquatic Center is being funded through a Campbell County Community Public Recreation District grant as well as funds previously set aside by Campbell County School District and designated for the Aquatic Center. These funds

must be used for their designated purpose.

Trustee Celebrations Trustees were appreciative of all the hard work that went into the district reopening plan.

Also celebrated was the partnership with Campbell County Health on the Kid Clinic, and the partnership with the City of Gillette and Campbell County Community Public Recreation Board on the Aquatic Center. These entities have worked together to

provide facilities for the community.
