

## 5145 Law Enforcement Officers in the School

Campbell County School District recognizes that maintaining a safe learning environment is a necessary component in the educational process. The District ~~wishes~~ **will make every effort** to cooperate with law enforcement officers in a manner helpful to law enforcement agencies and least disruptive to the educational process. The District shall encourage and promote the use of school resource officers to assist administration in maintaining a safe learning environment.

The District has legal custody of students during the school day and during the hours of approved extra-curricular activities. Law enforcement officers have ample opportunities to talk to students away from school and before or after school hours. ~~They should be encouraged to do so.~~ It is the preference of the District that contacts between law enforcement officers and students which involve interviews, arrests, or subpoenas take place outside normal school hours.
