Dr. Ayers listed the topics for the meeting: 1) Back-To-School Update

Back-To-School Update - Mr. Eisenhauer shared a back-to-school update with the board. The Summer Enrichment Program just finished and was very successful, with 850 elementary students attending. Secondary Summer School ends next week, and a success worth noting is that a student will earn their diploma. Principals will report back to their buildings on August 1, football practice begins on August 8, the first day of school is August 22, the last day of school is May 24, and parent/teacher conferences are October 20 and 21. The district is on a two-year cycle for calendars, and the calendar committee will begin the process of creating drafts for 2023-2024 and 2024-2025, which will go to the board for approval in the fall. Enrollment has been stable at approximately 8700 students. COVID numbers were very low at the end of the 2021-2022 school year, and the district will continue to review and monitor the COVID plan. One change that will occur in the plan is the systematic screening room at each school will be discontinued. Mr. Eisenhauer reviewed the Nutrition Department School Meal Program 2022-2023 flyer and shared that Federal COVID-19 free meal waivers were not extended for 2022-2023. Building principals will provide meal information to families during parent open house meetings and back-to-school newsletters in an effort to ensure students who qualify can receive free or reduced meals. Parents can put money on student accounts and apply for free and reduced meals through the link on the district website at payschoolscentral.com or by paper applications available at all schools.

The meeting adjourned at 5:40 pm, with no action taken by the board.
