Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC)

Denton Knapp, Executive Board Member for the Campbell County Veterans Council, provided information regarding the Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) and the potential to establish programs in the District. JROTC is one of the largest character development and citizenship programs for youth in the world, and its mission is "To Motivate Young People to be Better Citizens," which is the guidepost for the program's success. Mr. Knapp would like to put forth the effort to establish a program in the district. After discussion, more information on the logistics and student interest will be gathered and brought back to the board.

Educational Technology Update

Director of Technology Brian Knox provided an educational technology update on the following:

- Securing the infrastructure - by the end of summer, installation of locking cabinets and/or locked rooms will almost be 100% complete; WY ETS has updated our filter systems; Classroom Management - secondary teachers can monitor student devices in the classroom; MDM-possible upgrading to allow staff access to apps on their classroom devices
- Evaluating the usefulness of our abundance of technology equipment - Asking schools to evaluate the age of devices; creating replacement plans for each building; after this summer, installation of interactive flat-screen panels will be complete
- District Tech PD - free for all staff with 71 individualized options

Facility Update

Mr. Holmes provided a facility update and shared that the new Little Powder School is at 35% design; the new Aquatic Center site currently has 140 grouted columns complete for the foundation, construction fencing is installed, and job trailers are on site.

On Tuesday, June 6, the School Facilities Commission, State Construction Department, and School Facilities Division will hold a meeting for the purpose of

touring the District's transportation building and Campbell County High School. Board members are encouraged to attend.

On June 28, the Select Committee on School Facilities will tour Campbell County High School, and on June 29, they will hold their public meeting at Gillette College beginning at 8:30 am.
