#### LICENSED PHYSICAL THERAPIST

# **Purpose Statement:**

The job of Licensed Physical Therapist is done for the purpose/s of assessing students' functional physical development level; planning, implementing, and evaluating appropriate treatment/s to meet individual student objectives (Individualized Educational Plan); providing information to family and school personnel for program development and student placement; and providing information to instructional personnel on specific student issues.

This job reports to Assistant Superintendent for Special Programs

# **Essential Functions**

- Administers physical therapy procedures and modalities at a variety of locations (including occasional home visits) for the purpose of achieving IEP objectives.
- Assesses students gross motor skills and development (e.g. motor coordination, sensory development, muscle strength, etc.) for the purpose of determining their deficiencies and developing recommendations.
- Collaborates with teachers, parents, other personnel and/or outside professionals for the purpose of providing requested information, developing plans for services and/or making recommendations.
- Develops treatment plans and/or educational materials for the purpose of remediating students' motor skill deficits and ensuring compliance with state and federal regulations.
- Modifies physical surroundings (e.g. furniture, computer monitor, tools, etc.) for the purpose of providing tools required for student success in achieving IEP goals.
- Participates in a variety of meetings (e.g. parent conferences, in-service training, site meetings, etc.) for the purpose of receiving and/or providing information and/or meeting credential requirements.
- Prepares documentation (e.g. evaluations, observations, progress, contacts with parents, teachers and outside professionals, etc.) for the purpose of providing written support, developing recommendations and/or conveying information.
- Presents information on a variety of topics related to area of professional expertise in physical therapy (e.g. Children's Center, Hospital Care Givers, internal in-service training's, etc.) for the purpose of communicating information and gaining feedback on treatment issues.
- Procures equipment necessary for therapy program for the purpose of providing services in line with IEP.
- Researches resources and methods (e.g. intervention and treatment techniques, assessment tools and methods, community resources, etc.) for the purpose of determining the appropriate approach for addressing students' functional physical needs.

#### **Other Functions**

• Assists other personnel, as may be required, for the purpose of ensuring an efficient and effective work environment.

# Job Requirements: Minimum Qualifications

# Skills, Knowledge and Abilities

SKILLS are required to perform single, technical tasks with a need to occasionally upgrade skills in order to meet changing job conditions. Specific skills required to satisfactorily perform the functions of the job include: applying assessment instruments and translating data into treatment plans; operating equipment used in providing physical therapy; operating standard office equipment including pertinent computer software; and preparing and maintaining accurate records.

Job Description:Licensed Physical

KNOWLEDGE is required to perform algebra and/or geometry; read technical information, compose a variety of documents, and/or facilitate group discussions; and analyze situations to define issues and draw conclusions. Specific knowledge required to satisfactorily perform the functions of the job includes: concepts of grammar and punctuation; health standards and hazards; safety practices and procedures; stages of child development; abnormal development and medical diagnoses related to special Education funding categories; current PT treatment methodologies; and pertinent codes, policies, regulations and/or laws.

ABILITY is required to schedule a number of activities, meetings, and/or events; gather and/or collate data; and consider a number of factors when using equipment. Flexibility is required to work with others in a wide variety of circumstances; work with data utilizing defined and similar processes; and operate equipment using a variety of standardized methods. Ability is also required to work with a diversity of individuals and/or groups; work with similar types of data; and utilize a variety of types of job-related equipment. In working with others, problem solving is required to analyze issues and create action plans. Problem solving with data requires independent interpretation of guidelines; and problem solving with equipment is moderate. Specific abilities required to satisfactorily perform the functions of the job include: adapting to changing work priorities; communicating with diverse groups; maintaining confidentiality; working as part of a team; working with detailed information/data; and maintaining effective working relationships.

#### Responsibility

Responsibilities include: working under limited supervision following standardized practices and/or methods; leading, guiding, and/or coordinating others; and operating within a defined budget. Utilization of some resources from other work units is often required to perform the job's functions. There is a continual opportunity to impact the Organization's services.

#### **Working Environment**

The usual and customary methods of performing the job's functions require the following physical demands: significant lifting, carrying, pushing, and/or pulling; some climbing and balancing; frequent stooping, kneeling, crouching, and/or crawling; and significant fine finger dexterity. Generally the job requires 20% sitting, 40% walking, and 40% standing. The job is performed under some temperature extremes and some hazardous conditions.

**Experience** Job related experience within specialized field is required.

**Education** Bachelors degree in job related area.
